2008 Logan County Shepherd's Club- Logan County Club Pig Association Scholarship Rules

1. Two (2) \$500.00 scholarships will be given per year to qualified applicants. T
2. Each person must fill out an application to apply.
Applications must be received by April 1st.
Scholarship winners will be announced by May 15th.
Scholarship money will be paid Jan. 1st when proof of attendance is provided to committee.
3. An applicant must be a graduating high school senior to initially apply.
If an applicant does not win in his/her first year of applying, the applicant may reapply every year until graduation from an institution of higher learning.
After and applicant has been awarded this scholarship, the applicant may not apply again.
4. An applicant must be currently taking a lamb or hog project in Logan County through 4-H/FFA or have taken a hog/lamb project within the last two (2) years.
5. Scholarship may be applied to an accredited college, adult education courses, or a technical school.
6. All applications received by the April 1st deadline will be reviewed by the scholarship committee and winners announced by May 15th.
