All Market Beef (beef steers, market heifers & dairy steers) entries are due

BY MIDNIGHT ON December 9th, 2023.

WEIGHTS FOR 2024

Beef Steers: 1000 lb. minimum Market Heifer: 1000 lb. minimum Dairy Steers: 1000 lb. minimum * Animals that do not meet their minimum/maximum weights will be sent home No re-weighs ** Exhibitors showing a beef steer, market heifer or dairy steer may tag up to 3 animals in any combination of the 3 species.

- <u>EIDs are acceptable identification</u>. If you need tags they are available at the Fair Office , Tuesdays 12-6pm
- DO NOT WAIT UNTIL LAST MINUTE TO SEND IN ENTRIES! ANY COMPLETE ENTRIES NOT RECEIVED BY MIDNIGHT ON 12/9/23 WILL BE INELIGIBLE.
- Lost tags need to be reported to the Beef Committee or Extension Office and replaced. If a lost tag is not reported and/or replaced, the animal will be ineligible to exhibit.
- No animal or exhibitor substitution is permitted once animals are weighed.
