First Year Project Members are required to complete all sections of the book and First Year Completion Project Activities 1-11 on page 41.

- Second Year Project Members are required to complete all of the Second year Completion Project Activities 1-10 on page 42 as well as Ride a training level Score test and score 55 percent or better in open competition. It is recommended that you refresh your mind on the book information each year as well as completing the yearly activities.
- ❖ Third Year Project Members and Higher should do the same as the 2nd year member as well as riding a training level competition higher than the years before. It is suggested that as a third year member or higher the member should try a self-determined Project 4-H 365.
