Logan County Dairy Ambassador Duties and Responsibilities

Duties:

- Attend all sheep shows during the Logan County Fair.
- Assist with market lamb portion of the Livestock Sale when not selling your own animal.
- Attend other fair events including the Opening Ceremony, Fair Queen contest (you will be announced at that show) and 4-H and FFA Awards (required). Don't forget 4-H dance and the fun day event for 4-H and FFA members. Other events as required by other royalty. Examples: Bake Sale, Chili cook-off, Cookie Decorating, etc.
- Participate in parades and other activities in the County. Support Logan County Jr. Fair at as many events as you can.
- Visit other County Fairs. (recommended- not required)

Responsibilities

- Remember that you represent the Logan County Jr. Fair and the Sheep industry year round, not just at fair time.
- Be friendly, courteous and support one another, share responsibilities and have fun!
- Be seen. You should be able to be at fair at least 75% of the time, representing the Sheep Industry, Logan County Junior Fair and Logan County Sr. Fair.
- Dress appropriately- you must adhere to sale/show dress code at all times concerning no crop tops, no tube tops, spaghetti straps, no farm names/company names. Use good judgment in length of skirts, types of jeans, shirts and shoes. Members of the Sr. Fair board and Jr. Fair along with members of the Sheep Improvement Association have the final say as to what is appropriate.
- Do **Not** wear your sash or crown during the times you are being judged or selling your animal. Take good care of the sash and crown, we cannot replace them – so don't wear them when you are washing animals, cleaning pens, etc.
- Introduce yourself to Fair Secretary, Fair Board President, 4-H Extension members and the Sheep committee for Sr. Fair board.
- Send a thank you note to sponsors. (*Information will be given to you at a later date.*)
