GENERAL GUIDELINES

1. Age of Participants:
 - Please note ages under specific project classes below.
2. Type of Evaluation:
 - Participants will have a personal interview evaluation with a judge.
 - Review the below classes to see breakdown of evaluations.
3. Participant to bring:
 - Completed project book.
 - One "project", includes scrapbook, sample of collection, or piece of art, made as a part of your 4-H project to use during the interview with the judge to show how well you can apply the skills taught in your project area.
 - A display representing their learning experience of the current project. The display should be limited in size to what the participant can maneuver on his or her own. Because of space limitations each participant removes his/her display from the judging area when the interview is completed.
4. Project Display at Junior Fair:
 - Projects may be displayed as part of your 4-H Club's Booth in the 4-H Building or as another Junior Fair Entry.
 - The 4-H'er may choose what is exhibited in the Junior Fair Booth.
 - Booth Setup is Friday, July 5th, 5:00 – 9:00pm and Saturday July 6th, 8:00am – 2:00pm. All booths need to be completed by 2:00pm on Saturday July 6th.
 - The 4-H'er may take what they need from the booth for judging and return it back to the booth when done with judging.
 - Booth Removal is on Sunday, July 14th, 8:00am – 5:00pm. All items needed to be removed Sunday, any items past 5:00pm will be discarded.

5. Awards & State Competitions

- Awards for this category will be announced and presented at the Awards Presentation Thursday, July 11th, 4:00pm in the Activity Building at the Fairgrounds.

365 Self-Determined Creative Arts

- All participants will be in one class:
 - 4-H Age 8 and over
- Must complete the Self-Determined Project Guide
- Examples of Creative Arts topics may be, paper crafting, fairy gardens, etc.
- It is up to the discretion of the 4-H Educator to place Self-Determined projects in the appropriate category.

496 My Favorite Things

- Participants will be split into two classes:
 - Junior – (4-H Age 13 and under)
 - Senior – (4-H Age 14 and over)
- The judge will evaluate the 4-H'er on:
 - 40% Knowledge, skill and understanding of the project
 - 30% Quality of exhibit and project records in documenting project accomplishments
 - 30% Interview Performance

497 Scrapbooking: A 4-H Guide to Preserving Memories

- Participants will be split into four classes:
 - 1st Year Junior – (4-H Age 13 and under)
 - 1st Year Senior – (4-H Age 14 and over)
 - 2nd Year or More Junior – (4-H Age 13 and under)
 - 2nd Year or More Senior – (4-H Age 14 and over)
- The judge will evaluate the 4-H'er on:
 - Quality of Oral Presentation
 - Overall Appearance of Display
 - Clarity of Display
 - Depth & thoughtfulness of Project
 - Sample Project Work
 - Project Book and Records Are Complete
 - Number & Level of Activities Are Appropriate for the 4-H'ers Age & Skill

592 Get Started in Art

- Participants will be split into two classes:
 - Junior – (4-H Age 13 and under)
 - Senior – (4-H Age 14 and over)
- 4-H'er should bring one "project" or design.
- The design may be:
 - An original design
 - An adapted or copied from a picture (bring original picture with you)
 - A project made from a kit
 - A combination of original design and kits/templates
- The judge will evaluate the 4-H'er on:
 - Design Elements (color, line, texture, form, space, movement, value)
 - Design Principles (emphasis, rhythm, proportion, balance, harmony, variety)
 - Quality of Technique and Workmanship (materials, finishing, care and durability)

593 Seeing Through Graphic Design

- All participants will be in one class:
 - 4-H Age 8 and over
- The judge will evaluate the 4-H'er on:
 - 40% Knowledge, skill and understanding of the project
 - 30% Quality of exhibit and project records in documenting project accomplishments
 - 30% Interview Performance
